Volunteers are essential to maintaining and improving our high quality program. We ask all parents/guardians who register their child in the program to volunteer in some way. Please review the volunteer opportunities below and **check those for which you are interested in volunteering.**

### Parent Volunteers

- **Team Parent** -- Ideally, 2 parents per team are needed to coordinate communication between parents and coaches/league on information such as practice schedules, special activities, volunteer needs, cancellations, and general issues/concerns. Email addresses of families will be provided to facilitate communication.
- **Shed Duty Volunteer** -- Available in "the shed" during one practice per week to assist in dispensing of first aid, ice bags, equipment, repair, etc. Substitutes are also needed as backup to the regularly scheduled parent.
- **DVD Contributor** -- Need one parent per team who will be the point person for your child's team for photos, video, etc... Responsible for culling through all photos to ensure each player and coach is represented and for submitting the selected photos/video to the DVD Coordinator.
- **Field Worker** -- Two individuals/game to "man" the chains; 1 or 2 people to help set up fields prior to first scheduled home game and/or help take down field set up at the end of the last home game each game day.
- **Picture Day Volunteer** -- Help coordinate the players on picture day.
- **Banquet Volunteer** -- Help with the end of season banquet by setting up tables in breakout rooms and/or registration table; set up banquet rooms as needed; help with check in; oversee food service; make desserts; and take down/clean up. Jobs are short, but important.
- **Community Awareness Coordinator** -- Focus on raising awareness of the program within the Glenview community; identify opportunities for volunteerism and public exposure (community parades, street fair, events).

### Coaching

- **Head Coach** -- Responsible for teaching all key aspects of football to the kids, preparing them for games, and inspiring good sportsmanship, teamwork and personal responsibility. Must have solid knowledge of football and time to commit.
- **Assistant Coach** -- Assists the Head Coach; organizes and supervises the team during practices by helping to run drills, plays and do whatever else is needed. In depth knowledge of football not required.

### Board Position

- **Treasurer** -- Need someone with accounting experience to help with the books. Knowledge of QuickBooks is helpful. Time commitment: a few hours a month.
